Day 1 Overnight Flight

Days 2 – 6 Novotel Paris Les Halles, Paris

On some dates alternate hotels may be used.

Day 1: Wednesday, February 23, 2028 Overnight Flight Iconic skylines of picturesque towers. A trend-setting culinary scene. The inspirational muse of the world's greatest artists. Fashion-forward *haute couture*. This is the "City of Light." Feel the essence of Paris as the locals do – with its chic cosmopolitan vibe and constant energy. You're on your way to a five-night stay in the thriving heartbeat of France.

Day 2: Thursday, February 24, 2028 Paris, France Be swept off your feet as the Paris of your dreams comes alive. Spend the day as you wish, settling into your centrally located hotel and exploring the city independently. As arrival times will vary, there is no scheduled sightseeing today. Tonight, say *salut* as you toast the beginning of your tour.

Day 3: Friday, February 25, 2028 Paris - The Louvre - Île de la Cité - Eiffel Tower Begin your Parisian discovery on foot with your tour manager in the heart of the city, known for its historic universities and vibrant streets. Continue to Île de la Cité, Paris's ancient core, where the Notre Dame Cathedral* rises along the Seine, an 850-year-old Gothic masterpiece steeped in history. Take in sweeping views of the city on a Seine River cruise, framed by Paris's iconic landmarks. Later, join a local expert for a visit to the Louvre Museum.** Enter through the iconic glass pyramid and explore centuries of art, from ancient sculptures to 19th-century masterpieces by artists like Rembrandt, Caravaggio, Michelangelo, and Leonardo da Vinci. End your day in an unforgettable dinner inside the Eiffel Tower,*** featuring classic French cuisine and unparalleled views of Paris. (B, D)

Day 4: Saturday, February 26, 2028 Paris - Optional Excursion to Versailles Be romanced by Paris – the whole day is yours for the taking. Perhaps you'll wander over to the Left Bank of the Seine and plunge into the bohemian atmosphere of the Saint-Germain-des-Prés neighborhood and indulge in a little retail therapy along the elegant Champs Élysées. Or, join an optional excursion to Versailles, where you'll explore King Louis XIV's magnificent Palace and formal Gardens,**** masterpieces of architecture and landscape design. Step back in time as you walk through the opulent State Apartments, including the legendary Hall of Mirrors, where history was made amid glittering chandeliers and gilded walls. This evening, a choice to experience Parisian nightlife during an optional dinner at the dynamic Paradis Latin***** for a champagne-flowing, can-can kicking, music-driven night at the cabaret. (B)

Day 5: Sunday, February 27, 2028 Paris - Optional Excursion to Normandy Enjoy the day on your own, exploring Paris however you wish. If you'd prefer to venture beyond Paris, you can choose to join a full-day optional tour to Normandy,***** retracing the history of World War II with visits to see the Mulberry harbor (an engineering marvel), the Normandy American Cemetery, and the D-Day landing site at Omaha Beach. (B)

Day 6: Monday, February 28, 2028 Paris: Montmartre Today, step into the shoes of a local and navigate *Le Métro*, the main mode of transportation for Parisians, and spend the morning exploring the hip, bohemian neighborhood of Montmartre. Blending artistic roots and quirky modernity, this 18th *arrondissement* neighborhood is home to classical painters and cultural provocateurs. After your guided walk, you can choose to visit the Sacré-Coeur* on your own and take in the city from this iconic hilltop basilica. Then, **it's your choice!** Venture into the Musée de Montmartre to get a glimpse into the roots of cabaret and the lives of Paris's most famous artists with a local guide **-OR-** step off the tourist trail for a peaceful stroll on your own through the Montmartre Cemetery. As the day and the journey come to an end, you'll gather with your fellow travelers for a farewell dinner. (B, D)

Day 7: Tuesday, February 29, 2028 Paris - Tour Ends *Au revoir!* Your tour comes to a close today. (B)

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 3. This means you're an on-the-go traveler. You don't want to miss a thing, so walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal. A moderately paced two-and-a-half-hour walking tour, covering several miles, hills, and uneven surfaces, is no problem for you. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable, as is climbing into and out of various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.). You can climb three flights of stairs easily and handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. Expect some longer days with early mornings or late nights balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. This level is not a fit for travelers who require mobility assistance devices.

Travel with an average of 37 people (maximum of 44).

Paris is mostly flat; however, the Montmartre area is quite compact and on top of a hill with cobblestone streets and uneven terrain. For our visit to Montmartre, we will use the metro and the funicular to get there. The full morning activity will last approximately 4 hours, and you should be prepared to stand for extended periods and to encounter crowds, including on public transportation.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at the time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

****On the rare occasion the Louvre Museum is not available, it will be replaced by another high-level Paris museum.**

***Notre-Dame and Sacré-Coeur do not require reservations for entry. Please note that guided visits inside are not permitted, and access is subject to**

the day's queue. Depending on the available free time, guests may or may not be able to enter.

*****Due to high demand for the Eiffel Tower restaurant, your dining time can be as late as 9:00 p.m. The restaurant will give you access to level 1 of the Eiffel Tower. Be prepared for security lines before reaching the restaurant. The menu, crafted by a renowned chef, is high-quality but offers no choices.**

*******Normandy Optional Tour:** If you choose this option, due to the long distances (approximately 360 miles / 579 km roundtrip), expect to start the day early in the morning and return late (approximately 12 hours from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m.).

******Paradis Latin may be considered unsuitable for children - consult your Tour Manager.**

******The Versailles optional tour must be purchased at a minimum of 90 days prior to departure.**

Hotel check-in on your day of arrival is 3:00 p.m. Rooms may not be available prior to that time.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability. Triple rooms are not available.

Paris has intense traffic, so the best way to move around in the city is by metro, but most Parisian underground stations do not feature escalators/elevators (only 9 stations out of 303 have elevators).

Versailles Palace

Enjoy an interesting visit to the incomparable Palace of Versailles. The palace and gardens of Versailles reflect the extravagant tastes of King Louis XIV, the "Sun King." On this excursion, travel by coach to Versailles, where your local guide will recount the history of the palace and lead you through the various rooms of the State Apartments. Of particular interest are the Queen's bedchamber and the famous Hall of Mirrors. You then have leisure time to explore the incredible gardens, some of the most famous in the world, which took over 40 years to complete. This option must be purchased and reserved no later than 90 days prior to the tour departure date. Once purchased, cancellation within 90 days of tour departure will be non-refundable. *Duration: Approximately 5 hours.* Please note a minimum of 15 passengers is required. Transportation is included.

Normandy: D-Day Beaches & American Cemetery

Retrace the history of World War II in Normandy. Trek north from Paris about 175 miles to Arromanche-les-Bains. See Mulberry Harbor, one of the greatest engineering feats of WWII that allowed the Allies to establish strategic bridgeheads on D-Day. Pause for a break then continue to the Normandy American Cemetery. Take time to pay respects to the 9,386 servicemen and women who have been laid to rest here. Conclude your time in Normandy at a D-Day landing site: Omaha Beach. *Duration: Approximately 12 hours.* Please note a minimum of 15 passengers is required. Transportation is included.
